We, undersigned, herewith certify that the a.m. shipment complies with the respective IMDG requirements of the Amdt34-08, being:

- Special Provision 300: Fish meal or fish scrap shall not be transported if the temperature at the time of loading exceeds 35°C or 5°C above the ambient temperature, whichever is higher.
- Special Provision 308: Fish scrap or fish meal shall contain at least 100 ppm of antioxidant (ethoxyquin) at the time of consignment.
- Special Provision 907: The consignment shall be accompanied by a certificate from a recognized authority stating:
 - a. Moisture content;
 - b. Fat content;
 - c. Details of anti-oxidant treatment for meals older than 6 months (for UN 2216 only);
 - d. Anti-oxidant concentration at the time of shipment, which must exceed 100 mg/kg (for UN 2216 only);
 - e. Packing, number of bags and total mass of the consignment;
 - f. Temperature of fishmeal at the time of despatch from the factory;
 - g. Date of production;

No weathering/curing is required prior to loading. When fishmeal is packed into containers, the containers shall be packed in such a way that the free air space has been restricted to the minimum.
