

CUSTOMER ADVISORY - TRANSPACIFIC SERVICES ASIA TO USWC – UPDATE ON MAERSK ENSHI 740N

Geneva, 24 October 2017

Dear Customers,

This advisory is to provide further information about the current situation of the MAERSK ENSHI voyage 740N. While details provided by the vessel operator MAERSK LINE are scarce, MSC feels it's important to relay information to all our clients with cargo currently stuck on board this vessel.

The MAERSK ENSHI collided with a fishing boat in the East China Sea causing large number of casualties among the fishing crew. Consequently, the MAERSK ENSHI is at anchorage and has been detained by the local authorities, pending further investigations. We are being informed by the vessel operator, that at present moment there is no outlook as to when the MAERSK ENSHI would be released by the authorities. We regret to inform, that we are currently not able to provide you with further details as to our plan of when and how the cargo on board the vessel would be made available for an onward journey.

We apologize for the inconvenience this uncertainty may cause you. While further delays are expected, we shall remain dedicated to keep you informed, as soon as we receive updates from the vessel operator.
